As the Sheet Metal/Body Repairer you will work under the supervision of the Body Shop/Welding Shop Supervisors and are responsible for performing damage and corrosion repairs to Transit buses and equipment, fabricating vehicle and equipment components from sheet metal and inspecting vehicle interior and exterior fittings and performing repairs as required.

As the Sheet Metal/Body Repairer you will be:

- Repairing and/or replacing the following: vehicle (Bus) body parts and components, sheet metal and fibreglass panels, automotive glass, such as windshields, passenger windows and mirrors.
- Repairing vehicle interior fittings such as passenger seat mounting frames, stanchions, flooring, etc.
- Performing bench layout work for the manufacture of sheet metal vehicle and building components and parts.
- Performing other related duties consistent with the classification, as required.

Your experience includes:

- High School graduate or equivalent, and
- One of the following Certificates:
 - o Journeyman Sheet Metal Worker **or** Journeyman Motor Vehicle Body Repairer Certificate, recognized by the Province of Manitoba **or**;
 - o AME Certificate (aircraft maintenance engineer license).
- Demonstrated history of acceptable safety, attendance and job performance relevant to this position.
- Demonstrated ability to operate the hand tools and equipment required to perform the work involved.

Requirements:

- Must possess a complete set of hand tools required for the position.
- Applicants will be required to undergo testing to determine their knowledge, skills and ability as they relate to the position.
- Applicants must possess and maintain a valid Manitoba Class 5 driver's license, in good standing and will be required to attain Class 2 through in-house training, within a time frame determined by management.
- All applicants must submit a detailed resume, <u>including copies of any related certificates and driver's</u> <u>license to be considered.</u>
- Must be physically capable of performing the duties of the position which can include but is not limited to
 working outdoors in potentially-extreme winter and summer weather conditions, working at heights, as
 well as indoors in an environment that may include exposure to dust, noise, vibration and diesel exhaust
 fumes.
- The successful applicant will be required to undergo a Medical assessment at the Occupational Health Branch.
- A Criminal Record Check satisfactory to the employer as well as a Driver's Abstract from the Manitoba Highways & Transportation Department, Driver Vehicle Licensing & Motors Vehicles Branch will be required from the successful applicant(s), at their expense.
