Under the direction of the Manager, Asset Management Office or the Senior Projects Engineer, the Project Manager will provide leadership and guidance in the execution of assigned projects within Transit's \$587 million **Southwest Rapid Transitway** and **Pembina Highway Underpass** projects, through an integrated multi-disciplinary team approach that strives for innovation, excellence and efficiency. This position will manage assigned projects throughout their respective lifecycles ensuring effective teamwork and communication, high standards of work quality and organizational performance, and continuous learning.

The Project Manager will, initiate, lead, facilitate, coordinate, and provide direction, monitoring and oversight activity for assigned projects and ensure the benefits of the investment are realized in an efficient and effective manner. This position is expected to develop and maintain strong relationships with project stakeholders throughout the project lifecycle.

#### As the Project Manager you will:

- Responsible for the overall direction, coordination, implementation, execution, control and completion of specific projects.
- Manages project resource allocation including assembling and coordinating project staff.
- Undertakes Project Contract Administration when external contractors are involved once the project is approved.
- Prepares Requests for Proposals, Requests for Quotations, Contract Plans, Specifications and Estimates for Tenders, evaluate tendered bids and make recommendations for the Award of Contracts.
- Maintains relations with consultants, government agencies, developers, suppliers and contractors relative to facility and equipment design and improvements, and formulates sound recommendations
- Represents the Department at Public Engagement activities meetings with the public, stakeholders and councillors.
